This letter is relative to our permit to renovate the entrance to our lobby in the year 2001.

The work on the lobby was completed in 2001, but a condition for the issuance of the permit was that we would commit to do a sidewalk and drainage improvement in the front of our property. We had a timetable of completion by September of 2006.

We did commit time and money toward that project by contracting with Otomo Engineering for the drafting of plans and securing the necessary permits. Most of the preparatory work has been completed, by Mr. Stacy Otomo.

The purpose of this letter is to seek an extension to the completion date. The reason for this request is that in an adjoining area there will be major work done that may overlap our project. This is the building of a condominium and park by Intrawest. We have had conversations with Mr. Steve Sewall, Intrawest's project manager, and we would prefer to do the

work in conjunction with their requirement to improve the roadway at the entrance to Lower Honoapiilani Road. It would minimize the inconvenience to the vehicular traffic to do both projects simultaneously. We, at Kaanapali Shores, would be willing to meet with you and discuss this request.
