ADDITIONAL ANSWER:

ANSWER OF JUE ANAMI (w).

And now comes JUE ANAMI and, claiming a legal interest in the lands prayed for to be partitioned in this case, answers the petition of the Petitioner as follows -

I.

That she is the sole owner in fee simple by purchase of the shares of Kaleiopu, Hoonoho, and Pohaku in the said lands, the said Kaleiopu, Hoonoho, and Pohaku being three of the original grantees of said lands under the deed of C. R. Bishop and wife to Naispaakai et al., dated October 18, 1854, and recorded in Liber 13, pages 84 et seq., and being three of the original members of the said Hui of Mailepai.

II.

That the source, derivation, and devolution of her title, interest, and claim in said shares and interest in said lands are as follows:-

1. On June 20, 1918, Mery Palau and Nawi, who claimed to own said shares of Kaleiopu and Hoonoho, and, this respondent was then informed and believed that they were such owners, sold and conveyed all their right, title and interest in said shares to Dick Kekona Diamond by deed now of record in Liber 495, page

page 490.

2. On October 30, 1925, and December 30, 1925, the said Dick Kekone Diamond sold and conveyed all his lands in the Territory of Hawaii to one D. P. Keawehaku, the said deeds being now of record in Liber 722, page 392, and Liber 904, page 138.

3. That, by deed dated March 15, 1930, and of record in Liber 1050, page 197, the said D. P. Keawehaku sold and conveyed said shares to this respondent.

4. On July 9, 1930, Benjamin Kaleiopu Jr. who claims to own said share of Pohaku, and, this respondent was then informed and believed that he was such owner, sold and conveyed all his right, title and interest in said share by deed now of record in Liber 1052 pages 481-482.

III.

This respondent has no knowledge nor information how Petitioner acquired its interest in said lands.

IV.

This respondent denies that the Petitioner or any other person has any right, title and interest in and to said shares, or any part thereof.

WHEREFORE, this respondent prays that she be decreed to be the owner in fee simple of said shares and interest in said lands, and that the same may be partitioned to her.
