O R D E R .

The motion to strike the claim of respondent Lilia Kamaka Kahlbaum came on regularly to be heard on April 10, 1933, Ahuna Waikalooa being represented by Enos Vincent and A. E. Jenkins appearing for Lilia Kamaka Kahlbaum, and the Court being fully advised in the premises:

IT IS ORDERED that the motion of Ahuna Waiakalooa, respondent, to strike the claim of Lilia Kamaka Kahlbaum, formerly known as Lilia K. Kaholua, which claim was filed on October 28, 1931, is granted. The motion of Lilia Kamaka Kahlbaum filed in the above entitled cause to stay proceedings is denied.

It appearing from the report of the Commissioners in the above entitled cause that the respondent, Mary B. Waikalooa, was allotted Lots 44 A, 44 B and 44 C and that the Court in its final decree filed herein on November 21, 1931, made no disposition of said report of said Commissioners in so far as the respondent, Mary B. Waikalooa is concerned:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the report of the Commissioners recommending said allotments to the respondent Mary B. Waikalooa is hereby approved.

And It Is Ordered and Decreed that Mary B. Waikaloa is the owner of and entitled to Lots 44 A, 44 B and 44 C, said lots being fully described by metes and bounds in the final decree in the above entitled cause filed November 21, 1931, subject however to that certain mortgage to the Bank of Hawaii, Ltd. dated March 6, 1931 and recorded in the Registry of Conveyances in Honolulu in Liber 1105 on page 25.

It appearing further that the Commissioners in the above entitled cause in their report recommended that the respondent Ahuna Waikaloa be allotted Lot 44 D and that the Court in its final decree dated November 21, 1931 made no disposition of said report of the Commissioners in so far as it concerned said Ahuna Waikaloa, respondent herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the report of the Commissioners recommending said allotment to the respondent Ahuna Waikaloa be and the same is hereby approved.

It Is Further Ordered and Decreed that the respondent Ahuna Waikaloa is the owner of and entitled to the possession of Lot 44 D, same being fully described by metes and bounds in the final decree of this Court in the above entitled cause dated November 21, 1931, subject however to that certain mortgage to the Bank of Hawaii, Ltd. dated March 6, 1931, and recorded in the Registry of Conveyances in Honolulu, in Liber 1105 on page 25.

The Commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver a deed to Mary B. Waikaloa for Lots 44 A, 44 B and 44 C upon payment by said respondent of all expenses, costs or charges that may be due and assessed against said lots. The Commissioners are further directed and authorized to execute and deliver a deed to Ahuna Waikaloa, respondent herein, for Lot 44 D upon the payment by said

respondent of all charges, expenses or costs that may be due  
and assessed against said lot.
