



Kapela Castroverde, be and they are hereby declared to be the only heirs of Kahili Kalawaia, deceased, and as such heirs are entitled to all that certain piece or parcel of land heretofore decreed by this Court in its final decree and set aside to the heirs of the said Kahili Kalawaia, deceased, and being Allotment 35b and described by metes and bounds as follows:

A portion of L.C.A. 5524, R.P. 1663 to L. Konia in the Ahupuaa of Alaeloa, Kaanapali, Maui, T. H.

Beginning at a 1" iron pipe on the Honolulu-Lahaina Government Road, the coordinates of which referred to Government Triangulation Station "MALO" are

14,295.8 feet South and  
11,794.5 feet West, and running thence by true azimuths:

1. 29° 51' 00" 42.99 feet along the Government
2. Road on the arc of a circular curve of a radius of 365.49 feet for a central angle of 30° 45', the direct azimuth and distance being
3. 14° 28' 30" 193.81 feet, thence
4. 45° 00' 00" 8.0 feet, to seashore, thence along the seashore to Allotment 35a, the direct azimuth and distance being
5. 139° 00' 00" 267.06 feet, thence
6. 209° 51' 00" 150.00 feet along Allotment 35a to Hui Road "E", thence
6. 299° 51' 00" 203.0 feet along Hui Road "E" to the point of beginning, containing an area of 0.9781 acre, more or less.
