The petition of William Alama, also known as Willie Kapela, Fred Alama, also known as Fred Kapela, and May Alama Castroverde, also known as May Alama Rapela Castroverde, to declare the heirs of Kahili Kalawaia, deceased, came on to be heard on Saturday, the 7th day of August, 1937, and from the evidence adduced the Court finds that Kahili Kalawaia married Kaeaka; that the said Kahili Kalawaia and Kaeaka are both dead and left surviving them as their heir one son, Alama. That Alama married Lilia; that the said Alama and Lilia are both dead and left surviving them three children, namely, William Alama, also known as Willie Kapela, Fred Alama, also known as Fred Kapela, and May Alama Castroverde, also known as May Alama Kapela Castroverde. That the three children of Alama and Lilia named herein are the only children and heirs at law of Kahili Kalawaia, deceased, and good reason appearing therefor:

IT IS HEREEY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that William Alama, also known as Willie Kapela, Fred Alama, also known as Fred Kapela, and May Alama Castroverde, also known as May Alama

Kapela Castroverde, be and they are hereby declared to be the only heirs of Kahili Kalawaia, deceased, and as such heirs are entitled to all that certain piece or parcel of land heretofore decreed by this Court in its final decree and set aside to the heirs of the said Kahili Kalawaia, deceased, and being Allotment 35b and described by metes and bounds as follows:
